ELEMENTARY ED 4-6 GRADE TEACHER

Job Description

The Elementary Teacher provides instruction for students 4-6 grades in a multi-grade classroom. The teacher provides support for students in a nurturing learning environment and documents student learning outcomes. The Elementary Ed teacher supports and assists in student's achievement in Ojibwe Language and Cultural Teachings as offered by the elders, staff, and community. The teacher will also engage with families and the community to advance their own knowledge of the Minisinaakwaang community.

Duties

- Provide Elementary Education instruction in the MLA multi grade classroom 4-6.
- Develop or adapt materials and lesson plans based on MLA standards; provide direct instruction to individuals and groups, co-teach and/or collaborate with MLA k-12 teachers.
- Attention to students physically and emotionally needs in the classroom to fully understand student's social/emotional growth.
- Collaborate with the Ojibwe Language staff in the integration of Ojibwe language into the curriculum and lesson plans.
- Participate in the MLA team in developing and offering unique learning opportunities for students throughout the school year.
- Document all lesson plans and student learning outcomes in the MLA reporting system.
- Attend all MLA teacher conferences, staff meetings, and professional development trainings.
- Perform other tasks and responsibilities as assigned by the MLA Director.

Required Qualifications

- Bachelor of Arts Degree in Elementary Ed and State Licensure.
- Experience in working in a culturally based environment.
- Experience in the integration of technology into the classroom instruction.
- Demonstrated willingness to continue the advancement of one's own cultural skills via consultation with MLA Elders & MLA sponsored cultural events.
- Demonstrated ability to work professionally and ethically with students k-12, their families, and the community.
- Mandatory background check prior to employment required.
- Valid MN driver's license and reliable transportation.
